



## Piedras Viejas Laderas

Planted on the Pre-Cordillera slopes, due west of downtown Mendoza at an elevation of 5200 feet, Piedras Viejas is one of the most extreme vineyards in the world. This Piedras Viejas Laderas wine is a bottling of the north and south facing slopes of a small hill of almost pure limestone with a small granite intrusion. These plants only started production ten years after planting. Piedras Viejas is a new frontier in viticulture, that results in unique flavors and aromas. The first vintage was 2018.

Place of origin: Pre-Cordillera hillsides in El Challao, Las Heras, Mendoza.

Current vintages: 2018.
